SUBJECT: Divorce, Corollary Relief, Child Support, Application to Vary

SUMMARY: The appellant father asked the Nova Scotia Supreme Court to lower or eliminate his child support obligations. The Supreme Court judge denied this application, there being no material change in circumstances to justify a variance.

The father appeals to the Nova Scotia Court of Appeal.

ISSUE: Did the trial judge err in denying the appellant's application?

RESULT: Appeal dismissed. In denying the application, the trial judge committed no reversible error.
