SUBJECT:

LANDLORD AND TENANT - RESIDENTIAL TENANCIES ACT

SUMMARY:

The Supreme Court of Nova Scotia confirmed the report of the Residential Tenancies Board recommending **inter alia** that the appellant be required to vacate premises leased by him from the respondent.

ISSUE:

Whether the Residential Tenancies Board erred in finding that the provisions of the **Act** were complied with and thus whether the Supreme Court erred in confirming the report of the Board.

RESULT:

The Nova Scotia Court of Appeal held that it had not been shown that the Board had erred, and consequently the Supreme Court judge committed no error in confirming the Board's recommendation.
