**Subject:** *Partnership - Breach of Contract*

**Summary:** Messrs. Savoy and Amirault were dismissed from their functions with a partnership because they had tried to oust the management of one of the corporate partners. Under the partnership agreement, the partnership was dissolved because of the dismissal for cause. They sued for breach of contract and inducing breach of contract. The trial judge dismissed the claims.

**Issue:** The main issue on the appeal was whether there was cause for termination under the wording of the Partnership Agreement.

**Result:** The Court of Appeal dismissed the appeal. The trial judge did not err in his conclusions that there was just cause for dismissal and that the claims should be dismissed.
