SUMMARY: The appellant grows seaweed in salt water tanks in a building

on its property. The Board classified the property as commercial and subject to business occupancy tax. The appellant appealed, arguing that in view of its aquaculture activities the assessment classification should be "farm property" as defined in s. 2(1)(g) of the *Assessment Act*.

ISSUE: Did the Board err in law?

RESULT: Appeal dismissed. The Board made no error of law warranting

judicial intervention.
