cross-appellant.

ISSUES: Whether the trial judge erred in fact or law, in finding the

appellant and cross-appellant were negligent, in determining causation and in apportioning liability.

RESULT: Appeal and cross-appeal dismissed. There was sufficient

evidence to support the findings of fact and conclusions of

the trial judge. No error of law.
