Summary: The trial judge ordered \$1300 monthly maintenance to be reviewed one year later. The appellant had a gross monthly income of \$4500 per month and the respondent had no income or assets. The respondent was living in a trailer with her elderly father.

Issue: Did the trial judge err?

Result: Appeal dismissed. The Court was not persuaded that the trial judge's decision contained any material error, serious misapprehension of the evidence or any error in law.
