**Summary:** The judge of the Supreme Court (Family Division) ordered Ms. S. to pay \$1033 per month as interim child support for her two children. Ms. S. appeals the interim child support.

**Issue:** Did the judge commit an appealable error?

**Result:** The Court of Appeal dismissed the appeal. The judge made no error in principle and her decision caused no patent injustice. The amount of the child support followed the Child Support Guidelines. The judge properly left the other issues raised by Ms. S. for the final hearing.
