Reasons for judgment: (Orally)

[1] We are unanimously of the view the appeal should be dismissed. We agree with the application judge there was no decision of the Town of Antigonish to be judicially reviewed by the Court. The appeal is dismissed with costs of the Town of Antigonish in the amount of \$1,000, inclusive of disbursements, to be paid \$500 by the Federation of Agriculture and \$500 by the County of Antigonish.
