SUBJECT: Custody/care and control.

SUMMARY: Trial judge ordered that day to day care and control of the three children of the marriage be with the father. Mother appealed.

ISSUES: Did the trial judge err in so ordering?

RESULT: Appeal dismissed. The trial judge's conclusion that it was in the children's best interests to reside with the father is supported by the evidentiary record. (Fact specific)
