MATTHEWS, J.A.:


The appellant pled guilty to the charge of the attempted murder of his wife. On June 3, 1991, Judge Peter Ross sentenced him to seven years incarceration and imposed a firearm prohibition for five years. He now seeks leave to appeal and if granted, appeals from the sentence of incarceration.


The sentencing judge in a reserved 14 page decision carefully reviewed the facts of the case, the principles of sentencing and the cases referred to him by counsel. Upon review of the record, the factums of counsel and hearing oral submission by counsel, we see no error on the part of the trial judge which would permit this Court to reverse his decision.
