Summary:	The appellant appeals his convictions for counselling arson and perjury, and seeks a new trial. He claims that he received ineffective representation by both his trial counsel. He complains that their lack of preparation, poor cross-examination and low overall competence and professionalism caused a miscarriage of justice.
Issues:	Whether the appellant received ineffective assistance of counsel at trial.
Result:	Appeal dismissed. The appellant did not establish that his counsel's representation at trial resulted in any miscarriage of justice.
