Summary: Dispute over lands Ms. Hatt claimed to have acquired

prescriptive title. The occasional use of lands by a friendly neighbour was not sufficient to establish adverse possession. Even if the actions of the appellant were sufficient in nature to establish a possessory claim, the occupation was interrupted when the true land owner went upon the lands. The limitation

was reset each time the true owner returned to the land.

Result: Appeal dismissed with costs in the amount of \$2,500 plus

disbursements payable by the appellant to the respondent.
