Summary: Notice of appeal named Halifax Regional Police as a respondent despite that the trial judgment did not deal with the claim against Halifax Regional Police who had not been served with the originating notice.

Issue: Should the notice of appeal be quashed against the Halifax Regional Police?

Result: Notice of appeal quashed against Halifax Regional Police under **Rule** 62.11(e) leaving notice of appeal intact against that other respondents.
