Summary: By Order of the Family Court in 2000 the applicant father was

denied access to the parties' three year old daughter. In 2003 the father applied to vary the access order. The Family Court

judge granted access. Mother appealed.

Issue: Did the Family Court Judge err in ordering access?

Result: Appeal allowed and matter remitted to Family Court for a

hearing applying proper principles. The judge erred at law in neglecting to consider whether there was a material change in circumstances since the making of the earlier order, which change is the necessary foundation to a variation application (see **Maintenance and Custody Act**, R.S.N.S. 1989, c.160,

s.37).
