Summary: Workers' Compensation Board withheld benefits from worker

because in 1991 the worker had received a settlement of his law suit in Texas against his employer. His award was made in 1989

under the former Workers' Compensation Act.

Issue: Does s. 32 of the current *Workers' Compensation Act* (1996)

entitle the WCB to withhold payment of a 1989 continuing award because of the workers' 1991 receipt of settlement funds from his

employer?

Result: Section 32 of the 1996 *Act* applies only to workers who had a right

of action on or after the *Act* came into force. Section 32 does not apply to a right of action which was settled in 1991. The Workers'

Compensation Board was not entitled to withhold payment.
