THIS SUMMARY DOES NOT FORM A PART OF THE JUDGMENT OF THE COURT

Facts: The offender was an investment advisor who defrauded thirteen clients of investments of at least \$200K. The offender entered an early guilty plea, and had been co-operative with authorities. No prior record. No evidence of extravagant lifestyle. Significant victim impact. The Court determined the offender to have committed a breach of trust, and doubted the sincerity of the offender's remorse. Total penitentiary sentence of 30 months imposed. Court granted s. 738 stand-alone restitution orders for most of the losses.
