**Subject:** *Habeas Corpus*; Territorial jurisdiction

**Summary:** Inmate commenced action for *habeas corpus* in NSSC while housed in Springhill Penitentiary, Nova Scotia. Inmate then transferred by CSC to Dorchester Penitentiary, New Brunswick. Crown objected to the NSSC maintaining jurisdiction

**Issues:** Can a provincial superior court assert jurisdiction over an inmate housed in another province?

**Result:** Test outlined for maintaining jurisdiction; jurisdiction of the NSSC in this case is declined.
