SUBJECT: Foreclosure and Sale

SUMMARY: Section 42 of the *Judicature Act*, which provides for a discontinuance of

a foreclosure and sale proceeding is not available when the term of the mortgage and renewals have ended. It also requires as a prerequisite, payment of arrears. The mortgage was fourteen months in arrears and

there was insufficient evidence to grant an adjournment.

FINDING: The order for foreclosure and sale will be granted.
