SUBJECT: Criminal law, Sentencing, Possession for the Purpose of Trafficking in

Cocaine.

SUMMARY: The Offender was found guilty by a jury of possession for the purposes

of trafficking in cocaine. The drug has a street value of \$25,000 to \$30,000. He also plead guilty to obstructing justice by giving the police

a false name.

ISSUE: The appropriate sentence.

RESULTS: The Court accepted a joint recommendation of 4½ years imprisonment for the

drug offence and 30 days concurrent for the obstruction offence. Again by joint submissions the $4\frac{1}{2}$ year sentence was reduced by 3 months as a *Charter* remedy for the Offender being arbitrarily detained (as earlier determined by

the Court).
