Subject: Application for discharge from Bankruptcy. Responsibility of trustees in preparing s.170 report.

Summary: Whether trustee in preparing s.170 report should allow buy back of pension credits as an expense, allow a loss from a personal business to be set off against income from employment, allow expenses of an automobile and allow expenses of future dental work.

Issue: See summary.

Result: Court agreed that the trustee was correct in not allowing such expenses in making recommendation in its s.170 report. Court is not bound by the trustee's recommendation. Court accepted the recommendation except that it made an allowance in the exercise of its discretion for certain medical and dental expenses.
