Subject: High conflict family. Supervised visitation between a parent and her children.

Summary: History of court orders reflecting primary residence of children with father and supervised access with mother which evolved over time to significant unsupervised access providing the mother complied with a prohibition against contact between the parties' children and an individual who fathered another child with the mother.

Issue: Factual based issue relating to evidence regarding degree of compliance with a supervision order.

Result:

Facts support historic noncompliance. Significant restrictions placed on supervised contact between the mother recognizing the probability of noncompliance with the court ordered prohibition.
