**Subject:** Divorce, division of matrimonial property and debts, child support and

spousal support.

**Summary:** This was a 17 year marriage. The wife is on disability benefits and awaits

the results of litigation on an accident claim. The husband disputes the need for long-term support. The parties have numerous debts that remain unpaid, including significant legal fees incurred by the wife regarding their son. The husband seeks to have his family debts included in the

division.

**Issue:** The division of debts and a request for termination of spousal support.

**Result:** Divorce granted. Indefinite spousal support awarded at this time subject

to review. The family debts were not included in the matrimonial debt nor

were the legal fees. Reasonable costs of expenses to repair the matrimonial home found to be the joint responsibility of the parties.
