HEARD: At Halifax, Nova Scotia, on September 26, and 27, 2000.

DECISION: December 14, 2000.

SUBJECT: Criminal Law - Taxation of legal expenses.

SUMMARY: Mr. Innocente had previously successfully applied to have some of his property which had been seized pursuant to section 462.32 of the **Criminal Code**, released to pay for his legal expenses pursuant to section 462.34 of the **Code**. The court taxed Mr. Innocente's reasonable legal expenses pursuant to subsection (5.2) of section 462.34.

RESULT: Mr. Innocente's reasonable legal expenses were taxed at \$53,258.79.
