Summary: Injunctions were issued under the *Bank Act* prohibiting Mr. Weir from making proxy solicitations for the bank's annual meeting and requiring him to name those he had already solicited. The bank alleged that a message he posted on a blog and his failure to name the blog audience violated the order.

Issues: Whether Mr. Weir was in contempt of the injunctions?

Result: The orders did not prohibit the kind of message Mr. Weir posted, nor did they require him to name the blog or its audience.
