payment of the plaintiff's claim.

Issue: Does the Small Claims Court have jurisdiction to hear the

plaintiff's claim?

Result: The proceeding is not to be transferred to the Small

Claims Court. The *Builders' Lien Act* provides actions pursuant to the *Act* are to be tried in the Supreme Court, and the plaintiff's claim for a declaration for the recovery of land or an estate or interest therein is therefore outside

the jurisdiction of the Small Claims Court.
