Summary: Rockwork did drilling and blasting for Allterrain under a verbal

lump sum contract. Rockwork registered a claim for lien more than

sixty days after Allterrain says the contract was complete.

Rockwork did work later, but Allterrain says the work was for repair of deficiencies. It moved for an order declaring the lien expired.

Issues: Whether claim for lien was registered in time?

Result: Not all the work was for repair and, in any case, the contract was not

complete when the work was done. Motion dismissed.
