Issue: 1) Assessment of past parenting practices on current parenting ability.
2) Minister's obligation to comply with s. 38 Children & Family Services Act - disclosure.

Result: 1) Minister's failure to disclosure results in an adjournment.
2) Parents fail to commit to a plan despite ample opportunity to

do so.

3) Child found to be in need of protective services and remain in care.
