pay child support for two children based on income of \$52,600. Mother applied to vary in 2010 and father filed and provided documentation showing his income was \$40,000 and threatened to apply for a reduction in

child support. Mother applied again in late 2011. Father filed a statement of income showing income of \$52,000. Closer to the hearing date, the father admitted to deceiving the mother and the court. Father provided

documentation showing income well above amount disclosed.

**Issue:** What is the father's income? Is an order for retroactive child support

appropriate? If so, in what amount?

**Result:** Retroactive child support order of \$171,786.00.
