Summary: Following a 3-day divorce trial the Court awarded party and party costs in

the amount of \$7,000, plus disbursements. The wife's division of assets claim was unrealistically high. The Court considered the amount claimed, the amount awarded, and the amount the husband realistically knew to be at risk, to determine the "amount involved". Both parties' claims for spousal support were dismissed. Therefore, they were to bear their own costs in relation to that portion of the trial, which was approximately half. Consequently, the husband was only awarded the \$2,000 daily amount for

1.5 days.
