Introduction

[1] In my reasons deciding Mr. Denninger's variation application (reported at 2018 NSSC 314), I ordered Mr. Denninger produce his 2017 income tax return, notice of assessment and any notice of re-assessment. I reserved my right to adjust his 2017 child support payments if these materials did not confirm his annual income in 2017 was \$52,741.00.

[2] Mr. Denninger filed his 2017 notice of assessment, dated April 30, 2018. It shows his annual income in 2017 was \$52,971.00 not \$52,741.00.

[3] At an annual income of \$52,971.00, Mr. Denninger must pay monthly child support of \$742.00 for January to November 2017. He must pay monthly child support of \$757.00 for December 2017.

[4] Where Mr. Denninger paid \$8,544.00 in child support in 2017, he owes \$375.00.

[5] Mr. Denninger has underpaid child support form 2016, 2017 and 2018 by \$1,023.00. He shall pay Ms. Ross this amount by March 31, 2019.
