Subject: Motion to Dismiss

Summary: The Defendants sought dismissal of the Plaintiff's action, on the basis that the Court lacked jurisdiction. Alternatively, the Defendants sought an order to dismiss, due to abuse of process.

Issue: Did the Court have jurisdiction?
Was the Court's process abused?

Result: Motions Dismissed.
Court had jurisdiction to hear the matter, involving the *Statute of Elizabeth*. Decision based on provisions of the *Judicature Act*, and historically under the case law of Nova Scotia.
Court not satisfied that the evidence demonstrated an abuse of process by the Plaintiff.
