Summary: Motion to amend pleadings;
Motion to transfer proceeding to the Nova Scotia Supreme Court (Family Division)

Issue: Should motions to amend and transfer proceedings be granted?

Result: Motion to amend granted. Neither prejudice nor bad faith established.

Motion to transfer proceeding denied. Central issue involved *Statute of Elizabeth*, not the *Matrimonial Property Act*. Provisions of *Judicature Act* relied upon for the Supreme Court to retain jurisdiction.
