**Subject: Criminal Law; Sentencing** 

**Summary:** The offender pleaded guilty to various weapons possession,

storage, and carriage offences under ss. 86(2), 88(1), 90,

92(1), and 96(1) of the *Criminal Code*, as well as one count of possession of marijuana for the purpose of trafficking under s. 5(2) of the Controlled Drugs and Substances Act. In addition to the marijuana, a search executed on his residence disclosed

possession of a metal shank, 15 rounds of .32 calibre

ammunition in a safe, five rounds of .32 ammunition and a five shot .32 calibre revolver in a bedroom. This was a first offence, and the offender was youthful, being 21 years old at the time of sentencing. He left school after grade 10. Prior to the charges he had worked full-time stocking shelves in a supermarket. Subsequently he had worked in several

temporary jobs. The sentencing judge concluded that the offenders "survivalist"-type beliefs gave him the idea that he was only doing what was necessary to survive in society. The pre-sentence report was generally positive. There was a joint

sentencing recommendation before the court.

## **Result:**

The sentencing judge accepted the joint recommendation, sentencing the offender to two years' imprisonment in a federal penitentiary followed by 12 months' probation. There was a mandatory ten-year *Criminal Code* firearms prohibition order and a forfeiture order in respect of exhibits seized in the police investigation. The sentencing judge recommended that the offender be considered for education and employment training during his sentence.
