Subject: Divorce – division of assets and debts

Summary: Less than 8 year marriage. The family land was deeded to the respondent 18 years prior to marriage. The respondent built the home 14 years prior to marriage and lived in it 2 years prior to marriage. Petitioner contributed little to the home.

Issues:

- (1) Is the petitioner entitled to equal division of the matrimonial home and unequal division of debts?
- (2) Is the respondent entitled to unequal division of equity of matrimonial home?

Result: Evidence supports an unequal division of the matrimonial home. Evidence supports a finding that debts were matrimonial. Equal division of debts.
