Subject: A review of an order made pursuant to the *Adult Protection Act*

Summary: The respondent, C. R., was found to be an adult in need of protection in October 2004. That finding has been reviewed periodically since that time and on each occasion the court concluded that C. R. continued to be an adult in need of

protection. She suffered from diagnosed mental illnesses which she does not admit and her condition has worsened. Because of the state of her mental health she was not willing to take her required medications and was not able to adequately care for herself.

Issue: Was C. R. still an adult in need of protection?

Result: C. R. is still in need of protection and the order was renewed.
Fact specific.
