Summary: The Husband requested a variation in the amount of spousal support to be paid and he also requested a termination date. The parties had been married for 18 years. There was one child living with the Husband from the date of separation in September 2006. The Wife had always worked during the marriage but earned less than the Husband. She had not been impeded in career or job development because of the marriage.

Issue: Was the Wife entitled to spousal support and if so in what amount and for how long?

Result: The Wife was entitled to spousal support in the amount of \$600.00 for a period of 6 years.
