SUBJECT: Administrative Law - Certiorari - Application to guash decision of

Board of Directors of housing co-op evicting member.

ISSUES: Does the decision of the Board of Directors evicting a member

trigger the appeal procedure provided by s. 29(2) of the Co-

operative Associations Act.

SUMMARY: After a dispute over rental arrears, the Co-op's Board of Directors

eventually obtained an order evicting Mr. Lapointe from his

residence. The Board continued with the eviction procedure even though Mr. Lapointe attempted to pay the arrears which had been in dispute. Mr. Lapointe wanted to appeal the Board's decision to the general membership pursuant to s. 29(2) of the Co-op Act but

the Board refused.

RESULT: Found the eviction of Mr. Lapointe was in effect exclusing him from

membership and that he had been denied his right to the procedure provided by s. 29(2) of the Co-op Act. Stayed the decision of the Board of Directors pending and subject to the completion of the

appeal procedcure provided in s. 29(2).
